


Step 6:



- White Belts have the Korean words for Unity (our school word) and Thank You.
- White and Yellow Belts have Korean Numbering 1 10. We count in every class!
- Orange belts have Korean Number 1 20, but also a YELLOW section for the
 Tenets.

Our goal was to keep things color coded, so you could remember what belt you learned some of the requirements in. All higher-level belts have the lower belt requirements listed, so you don't waste time trying to find what you need.
